Program Supply List / Student Costs:

Uniform requirements:

Dental I Uniform, Gray Scrubs – One scrub top and bottom (\$40) and a pair of shoes (\$20) is \$60. Two sets of scrubs and one pair of shoes is \$100. One individual set of scrubs (no shoes) is \$40. (CASH only to Dress Code due at fitting). **A uniform fitting date will be held on June 28, 2017 from 3:00 – 5:45 p.m.**

Dental II uniform, Gray Scrubs – same prices as above, ordered through Dress Code (360-695-9600) - **A uniform fitting date will be held on June 28, 2017 from 3:00 – 5:45 p.m.**

Required Fees Paid to CTA

(Prices subject to change)

Dental Year 1 total required fees paid to CTA by check or cash DUE by the SECOND WEEK OF SCHOOL is \$48.50. This fee covers CPR/First Aid (American Heart Assoc. BLS (Healthcare level) CPR and First Aid) \$45 and OSHA approved Safety Glasses \$3.50 each (If student alternates between contacts and prescription glasses, student will need two pairs of safety glasses).

CPR will be held on prearranged SATURDAY AND SUNDAY's, not in class. Each student will attend one day to complete class. Student will receive BLS book, First Aid book, and personal pocket mask with case in class and BLS CPR card issued on completion of class. If fees are unpaid by student or if student does not show up for signed up class, student is responsible for obtaining own BLS, First Aid Healthcare level CPR/First Aid costs in area (NW Regional Training Center \$112.25 or Red Cross \$145).

Optional Fees Paid to CTA

Dental Assistant Registration: \$40 Payable to Washington State Department of Health:

- Registration is required to work in a dental office in the state of WA *must be renewed annually for \$21. ** Department of Health may require student to be 18 years of age to register and background check with the state is required.

Required Proof of Immunizations and Medical Test

Dental I - The following documentation of current immunization records are required:

- Immunizations are requested to be completed **prior** to students starting the Dental program. The immunization record may be completed by one of the following: your family physician, your health care provider or by the Department of Health. You are required to bring a copy of your completed immunization record the first week of school. **Immunizations include:**
 - **Adacel** (DTaP, Diphtheria, tetanus and acellular pertussis vaccine is MANDATORY no matter when you have received your last tetanus booster),
 - **MMR** (Students must provide proof of 2 MMR vaccines after age 1 year),
 - **Hepatitis B** (series of 3 injections must be completed prior to participating in lab activities or contact with patients in clinical training courses)
 - **Annual PPD Tuberculin Skin test** (History of BCG vaccination is not a contraindication for PPD testing). The program needs a note from your physician clearing you of TB (results of whatever test was applied) prior to any student to student contact in lab or student to patient contact in clinic.

Dental II - We have vaccines on file from the previous year.

- TB skin test required annually: PPD (Tuberculosis Screening - History of BCG vaccination is not a contraindication for PPD testing).

Optional/Highly Suggested:

- Flu vaccine/H1N1 vaccine is optional, but highly suggested as students will be having direct contact with members of the community. The flu vaccine is recommended for all healthcare workers.

- 1 – USB /Thumb Drive (resumes, cover letters, presentations, etc.)
- 1 – Pkg Hair Ties, clips and pins (hair off-shoulders and out of eyes)
