## Program Supply List / Student Costs:

(Prices subject to change)

### Year 1:

- Navy Blue Blazer – purchase anywhere (\$15 - \$60+).
- CTA Fashion Merchandising and Management program patch to apply to blazer; cost is approximately \$10 paid through CTA office in the Fall.
- Workbook (Fashion – From Concept to Consumer by Gini Stephens Frings) approximately \$30 paid through CTA office in the Fall.
- Flash or jump drive is recommended.
- Additional art or fabric supplies \$50.
- Student must provide their own transportation to/from internship sites during April and May of the school year.
- Student must have proof of car insurance if driving to internship sites.

### Optional:

- National Retail Federation Certification exam fee \$55

### Year 2:
