Program Supply List / Student Costs:

Students will be issued firefighting gear and will be required to pay a \$120 lab fee (book, t-shirts, shorts, sweatshirt, and name tag)

Purchase separately:

- The fire districts require drug testing which will require payment to the contracted testing company of the student's choosing (Drug test to be done on student's own accord, district does not do prescreening.) Negative urinalysis drug screen no older than two months before the first day of class
- Cost of a sports physical
- Vehicle insurance required if student is driving to class

Other:

- Must provide own transportation to training site
- Student must have proof of car insurance if driving to internship sites.

The following immunizations are required:

- Hepatitis B vaccine series (started or completed) or signed waiver
- Negative TB test no older than one year prior to the first day of class

Mandatory requirement to attend Cascadia Tech Academy Fire Science Program:

Family medical insurance or student accident insurance.

Note: Student accident insurance is available through your sending high school.
