## Program Supply List /Student Costs:

(Prices subject to change)

Uniform required: A uniform fitting will be held on June 4<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 – 7:00 p.m. Uniform includes scrubs and gait belt. Cost for the uniform is \$55.00 for one uniform, \$100.00 for two, and \$145 for three (this includes tax). Acceptable payment is by cash only. Information for purchasing these items was provided at student orientation. Those that missed the fitting will have to wait until the first week of school.

Purchase separately:

- Shoes – White or neutral solid color leather or synthetic leather uppers, closed toed and closed heeled shoes only. No canvas, clogs, crocs, sandals, or open toed shoes are allowed for safety reasons.
- Watch (mandatory) - Analog with a second hand. No smart watches.

Additional costs:

- Name tag - \$2
- CPR training - \$50 – Required fees paid to CTA by check or cash by 9/28/2018. CPR will be held on a prearranged SATURDAY or SUNDAY, not in class. Student will register to attend class one of the scheduled days. Student will receive BLS book, First Aid book, and personal pocket mask with case in class and BLS CPR card issued on completion of class. If student does not show up for registered class, student will be responsible for obtaining own BLS, First Aid Healthcare level CPR/First Aid class. Comparable costs in the area are NW Regional Training Center \$112.25 or Red Cross \$145.

Optional costs:

- HOSA (Future Health Professionals formerly known as Health Occupations Students of America): \$15 OPTIONAL Membership – made payable to CTA, due by 9/28/2018.
- Nursing Assistant Certification state test is \$110\* (For those who qualify)  
\*These fees are set by the state of WA and are subject to change.
- Program Sweatshirt: Price varies by style, ordered online.

The following immunizations are required:

- Must have proof of immunizations including MMR, Hepatitis B series, and an updated Tdap
- Proof of negative TB test
- Influenza vaccine

Other:

- Student must provide their own transportation to/from internship sites.
- Student must have proof of car insurance if driving to internship sites.
