Program Supply List / Student Costs:

(Prices subject to change)

Year 1:

Uniform required: Black BDUs (battle dress uniform pants) which can be purchased from multiple vendors (including www.lapolicygear.com) for approximately \$20 per pair. Must be kept in good repair.

The following items are to be ordered before school starts from: <https://www.designsofallkinds.com/product-category/schools/cascadia-tech-academy/> . These items will be delivered to the school and distributed by the teacher.

- Criminal Justice Polo Shirt \$26
- Criminal Justice Workout shirt \$16
- Workout Shorts \$21
 - During fitness training students are required to wear the class exercise T-shirt and shorts (additional/replacement shirts can be ordered throughout the school year)

Purchase separately:

- Black leather or canvas belt that is strong enough to support equipment such as radios, handcuffs, and flashlights.
- Black boots, available at Big 5
- Black tennis shoes (for workouts)
- Police notebook with Miranda Warning (approximately \$3.50 each) for taking notes during mock scenes and interviews. (purchased from CTA office in student center after school starts)

Optional:

- Criminal Justice First Year Program Sweatshirt \$45

During class, all students are required to wear their CJ Program Uniform including BDUs, and appropriate black footwear. During fitness training students are required to wear the class exercise T-shirt.

Year 2:

- Same requirements as listed above.
- Students may have an opportunity to participate in Internships. Student must provide their own transportation to/from internship sites. Most internships require business-type/professional clothing or program uniform.

Optional items and activities:

- Criminal Justice Program Sweatshirt - \$45
- Criminal Justice Workout Sweatpants (optional) - \$22
- Mock Trial Team Competition (approximately \$50) is optional.
- Skills USA Regional Competition (approximately \$25) is optional.
- Law Day Conference in May – approximately \$10 (includes lunch)
- Youth legislature
- Clackamas Skills Competition
- EVOC training

Other optional conferences or learning experiences outside of school hours may have costs that would be the students' responsibility if they choose to participate or attend.

Mandatory requirement to attend Cascadia Tech Academy: Family medical insurance or student accident insurance.
