

# Dental

**Program Supply List / Student Costs:** (Prices subject to change)

## **Uniform requirements:**

**Dental I Uniform:** Gray Scrubs – One scrub top and bottom (\$45) and a pair of shoes (\$10) is \$55. One individual set of scrubs (no shoes) is \$45. (CASH only to Dress Code due at fitting). **Uniform fitting date: June 4, 4:00 – 7:00 p.m.**

**Dental II uniform:** Gray Scrubs – same prices as above, ordered through Dress Code (360-695-9600).

**Uniform fitting date: June 4, 4:00 – 7:00 p.m.**

## **Required Fees Paid to CTA**

(Prices subject to change)

**Dental I** - Program required fees for CPR/First Aid and safety glasses total \$53.50. These items may be paid for through the Skyward system under Family Access by credit/debit or in person in the Student Service Center by check payable to CTA, cash, or credit/debit. Payment is DUE by the second week of school covers:

- American Heart Association BLS (Healthcare level) CPR and First Aid \$50: **CPR will be held on Pre-Arranged SATURDAY's and SUNDAY's, not in class (each student will attend 1 day to complete class)**
  - BLS book
  - First Aid book
  - BLS CPR card
  - First Aid card
  - Personal pocket mask with case
- OSHA Approved Safety glasses \$3.50 each (If student alternates between contacts and prescription glasses, student will need 2 pairs of safety glasses)

**Note:** *If fees are unpaid by student or if student does not show up for signed up class, student is responsible for obtaining own BLS, First Aid. Examples of Healthcare level CPR/First Aid costs in area are NW Regional Training Center \$112.25 and Red Cross \$145 total.*

## **Optional Fees Paid to CTA** (Prices subject to change)

HOSA (Future Health Professionals formerly known as Health Occupations Students of America): \$20 OPTIONAL Membership – made payable to CTA, due by second week of school. \*Strongly recommended for 2<sup>nd</sup> year Dental.\*

WA HOSA Dues and Membership: If student competing for State and National competitions there are additional competition, travel, and hotel fees.

## **OPTIONAL – Fees Paid to Other Vendors** (Prices subject to change)

### **Dental II**

Dental Assistant Registration: \$40 Payable to Washington State Department of Health: Registration is required to work in a dental office in the state of WA. Must be renewed annually for \$21. \*\* Department of Health may require student to be 18 years of age to register and background check with the state is required.

### **Dental I/II** (Prices subject to change)

- American Dental Assistants Association Student Membership: \$35, add \$10 for professional liability insurance.
- Students successfully completing Dental I and Advanced Dental Program are eligible to apply for 2/3rds of the Dental Assisting National Boards, CDA, (DANB) examination, Oregon Radiology certificate, Oregon Expanded Functions certification.

**Note:** There are additional costs that occur when applying for the Dental Assistant Registration and the National Certifications.

### **Required Proof of Immunizations and Medical Test**

**Dental I** - The following documentation of current immunization records are required.

Immunizations are requested to be completed **prior** to students starting the Dental program. The immunization record may be completed by one of the following: your family physician, your health care provider or by the Department of Health. You are required to bring a copy of your completed immunization record the first week of school. **If you do not have information concerning your child's childhood immunization (booklets with dates) the student must be revaccinated.**

#### **Immunizations include:**

- **DTaP and Tdap** (Diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis) vaccinations are MANDATORY no matter when you have received your last tetanus booster.
- **MMR** (Students must provide proof of 2 MMR vaccines after age 1 year),
- **Hepatitis B** (series of 3 injections must be completed prior to participating in lab activities or contact with patients in clinical training courses)
- **PPD -Tuberculosis Screening (History of BCG vaccination is not a contraindication for PPD testing)**
  - All HCWs (Health Care Workers) must have an annual PPD Tuberculin Skin Test.
  - The PPD test required is a two-step test
  - If the first test is true positive, a physician referral is required, and you may be referred for a chest x-ray, and a consultation with a respirologist. The test results need to be recorded in your health care record. The record should also indicate what treatment, if any, was prescribed as a result.
  - If you have had a positive PPD in the past, do not repeat the test. You will need to consult your physician, and discuss if another chest x-ray is necessary. Again, the test results need to be recorded in your health care record. The record should also indicate what treatment, if any, was prescribed as a result.

**The Program needs a note from your physician clearing you of TB (results of whatever test was applied) prior to any student to student contact in lab or student to patient contact in clinic.**

**Dental II** - We have vaccines on file from the previous year.

- TB skin test required annually: PPD (Tuberculosis Screening - History of BCG vaccination is not a contraindication for PPD testing).

#### **Dental I/II - Optional / Highly Suggested:**

**Flu vaccine / H1N1 vaccine** - Students will be having direct contact with members of the community, the flu vaccine is recommended for all healthcare workers.

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**Mandatory requirement to attend Cascadia Tech Academy:** Family medical insurance or student accident insurance.

*Note: Student accident insurance is available through your sending high school.*

#### **Dental Year 1 Supply List**

- *Student Workbook for Modern Dental Assisting, 11<sup>th</sup> Edition* – ordered online, will need by 1<sup>st</sup> week of class, <http://www.us.elsevierhealth.com> or Amazon.com, approximate cost \$49.
- (2) Tri-board posters (can choose to reuse one)
- (1) WHITE or BLACK <1-inch> 3 ring binder (used for portfolio at mock interview time)
- (1) Package 10 sheet protectors (used with portfolio, will need more at end of year for certificates to be placed in portfolio)
- (1) Pencil box – hard plastic
- (1) Package Paper (college or wide) or composition book
- Thank You Notes (used for all guest speakers, providers, and volunteers), can be handmade
- Writing utensils (pencils, black or blue ink pens) can be a multi colored pen (RED/BLUE/BLACK)
- (1) USB / Thumb Drive (résumé, cover letter, presentation, etc.) or access to GOOGLE DOCS
- (1) Package hair ties, clips and pins (hair off shoulders and out of eyes)
- (1) Pocket notebook (clinic)
- (1) Package index cards (flash cards)
- (1) Email address (student first and last name within email, can be one from school, gmail, yahoo, or aol)
- **Socks must be worn daily**

- Closed toed shoes must be worn in the classroom (open toed- flip flops, Birkenstock's, sandals not allowed for safety purposes)

### Additional costs:

- Portfolio from last year (with copies in sheet protectors of: certificate(s), résumé, and cover letter, CPR/First Aid cards, and best works)
- (1) Package hair ties, clips and pins (hair off shoulders and out of eyes)
- (1) Package Paper (college or wide) or (1) Composition notebook (Notes)
- Package of Thank You Notes (used for all guest speakers, providers, and volunteers)
- Writing utensils (pencils, black or blue ink pens, highlighter(s) – yellow, pink, and blue) or Multi-colored pens (RED/BLUE/BLACK)
- (1) Package white Sculpy Clay, \*may use more than one package if you make large models
- (2) Pencil boxes – hard plastic (one for general lab materials and checked out instruments / supplies & one for personal pens/pencils)
- (1) Pocket notebook (clinic and internship)
- Copy of Car Insurance and Driver's License (internship)
- Copy of TB skin test (annually)

### Other:

- Must have own transportation to internship site
- Student must have copy of driver's license and copy of proof of car insurance if driving to internship sites.
