Year 1:

Required uniform: One technician Jacket and one crew shirt ordered from

Purchase separately:

- One pair of black work pants
- One pair of work boots or shoes (safety shoes recommended).

Optional:

- Skills USA membership dues, \$25. (Auto technology competitions and leadership activities)

Year 2:

- \$40 fee for ASE certification test series. (End of program exams/Auto industry certification)
- Student must provide their own transportation to/from internship sites.
- Student must have proof of car insurance if driving to internship sites.

Optional:

- Skills USA membership dues, \$25. (Auto technology competitions and leadership activities)

Mandatory requirement to attend Cascadia Tech Academy:

Family medical insurance or student accident insurance.
