Program Supply List / Student Costs:

Year 1:

- Required uniform consisting of one technician Jacket and one crew shirt ordered from [automotiveworkwear.com](http://www.automotiveworkwear.com) (see link below), one pair of black work pants, one pair of work boots, safety glasses. <https://www.automotiveworkwear.com/Uniforms/cascadia-tech-academy.html>.
 - ❖ Approximate cost for jacket and work shirt is \$90.
 - ❖ First pair of safety glasses provided. Replacements at student expense = \$6.

Optional:

- Skills USA membership dues, \$25. (Auto technology competitions and leadership activities)

Year 2:

- Automotive Technology uniform from year 1 (See Year 1 requirement)
- \$44 fee for ASE certification test series. (End of program exams/Auto industry certification)
- Student must provide their own transportation to/from internship sites.
- Student must have proof of car insurance if driving to internship sites.

Optional:

- Skills USA membership dues, \$25. (Auto technology competitions and leadership activities)

Mandatory requirement to attend Cascadia Tech Academy:

Family medical insurance or student accident insurance.

Note: Student accident insurance is available through your sending high school.
