Additional costs:

- OSHA Card **\$8** - check (or cash) due upon enrollment in OSHA 10. Purchase thru CTA's Student Service Center when school is in session.
- LAB FEE for Remote Control Aircraft Projects. ~ **\$62**. Due at the beginning of 2nd Semester (~Feb 1). Purchase thru CTA's Student Service Center when school is in session.
- Good supply of #2 mechanical pencils (recommend 'bic')
- 5 Foam Boards - 20"x30" (Dollar Tree, Wal-Mart etc.) ~ **\$5** + tax
- And a 12 pack of Dual Melt 10" glue sticks (Home Depot, Lowes, Wal-Mart, Amazon etc.) ~ **\$7** + tax

Optional:
