Program Supply List / Student Costs:

Year 1:

- Black or Navy Blue Blazer – purchase anywhere (\$15 - \$60+).
- Workbook approximately \$20. Purchase thru CTA's Student Service Center in the Fall when school is in session.
- Flash or jump drive is recommended.
- Additional art or fabric supplies \$50 (for end-of-year final project).
- Student must provide their own transportation to/from internship sites during April and May of the school year.
- Student must have proof of car insurance if driving to internship sites.

Optional:

- DECA membership and competition fees \$40

Year 2:

- Black or Navy Blue Blazer – purchased anywhere (\$15 - \$60+). May use the blazer purchased for Year 1.
- Workbook approximately \$20. Purchase thru CTA's Student Service Center in the Fall when school is in session.
- Additional art or fabric supplies \$100+ (for end-of-year final project).
- Student must provide their own transportation to/from internship sites during April and May of the school year.
- Student must have proof of car insurance if driving to internship sites.

Optional:

- DECA membership and competition fees \$40

Mandatory requirement to attend Cascadia Tech Academy:
Family medical insurance or student accident insurance.
