Program Supply List / Student Costs:

(Prices subject to change)

Items that will be provided for you:

- 1 Uniform duty shirt
- Full personal protective equipment (jacket, pants, boots, helmet, hood, and gloves)
- 2 Uniform t-shirts, 1 Uniform Sweatshirt, 1 Pair PT Shorts (lab fee)
- 1 Training rope
- 1 Name tape (lab fee)
- Passport nametags (lab fee)
- Helmet shield

Other items that need to be completed *prior to the beginning of the year*:

- One Textbook (IFSTA Essentials of Firefighting 6th Edition). [IFSTA](#)
- One Pair of uniform pants. Appropriate uniform pants would be navy blue in color only. No black work pants or jeans are allowed. Please do not buy royal blue work pants. Dickie brand pants are acceptable. Several uniform vendors in the Portland area sell uniform style pants. These style pants are not required, but may be purchased as a personal preference. - One Pair uniform boots or shoes. Black and polish-able. If Oxford style shoes are worn, black socks must be worn.
- Prior to issue of uniform t-shirts you will need to wear a navy blue t-shirt. No pockets, logos, or slogans are allowed on the t-shirt. No tank top or muscle style t-shirts allowed.
- One black uniform style belt. Plain leather or basket weave style is preferred. Plain silver buckle. No large or offensive buckles are allowed. No buckles with logos.
- You will need a three ring binder with dividers, college ruled notebook paper, two dark blue ink ballpoint pens (no black), a pocket sized note pad for your uniform shirt.
- Wristwatch with second hand or digital.
- Running shoes for physical fitness training.

Other items that need to be completed prior to the beginning of the year:

- **Physical examination (First and second year cadets)** a sports physical will work. It needs to be current for the upcoming school year. Make sure you have the physical form from me prior to receiving your physical. Most school physicals are good for *two years*.
- **Proof of TB test (First and second year cadets)** this will need to be done next year as well if you will be returning. Negative TB test – no older than one year prior to the first day of class
- **Proof of HBV immunizations (First year cadets)** these are required to fulfill your ride-out eligibility requirements. Hepatitis B vaccine series (started or completed) or signed waiver
- **Pre-employment drug urinalysis screening (First and second year cadets)** this *must* be completed prior to the first day of class. This means that I need the results back to me prior to the start of the year. If you do not have this test done prior to the first of the school year, you will not be allowed to start class until I receive the results. Please complete this test in early August.
- **All forms must be signed and returned by October 1st (First year cadets)** these include the emergency information and authorization for treatment, liability release, and consent for drug testing. You must provide proof of medical insurance to participate. Should you not have medical coverage, you will need to purchase a medical plan from the school district. Information on these plans is available from your home school. You will not be allowed to participate with the class until that information is provided. We will have a parent meeting around the second week of September to get all of this signed at once by the parents.

- **\$100.00 - \$120.00 non-refundable lab fee (First and second year cadets)** There is a 2-week grace period after the beginning of the semester to have this paid as fees vary by location. The instructor will provide details with exact amount during first week of class. Checks are to be turned in to a cadet instructor. Equipment will not be issued until this is paid.
- Make sure your hair length and appearance is taken care of prior to the beginning of the school year. We will be more than happy to provide haircuts on the first day.
- Remember, no earrings, nose piercings or rings, large necklaces, sunglasses, cd players, cell phones, pagers, etc. are allowed in class.
- Must provide own transportation to training site
- Student must have proof of car insurance if driving to internship sites.

Mandatory requirement to attend Cascadia Tech Academy Fire Science Program:

Family medical insurance or student accident insurance.

Note: Student accident insurance is available through your sending high school.
