****Uniforms must be purchased between the following dates to avoid a higher individual shipping charge: 7/1/2019 to 7/31/2019** (bulk order will be sent to CTA)**

Order the following items for the Kitchen and Front of the House:

- 2 Chef Jackets (plus sizes reflect higher cost) First & Last name on right side of jacket (ie. Joe Smith)
- 2 Bistro Aprons (black)
- 1 Bib Apron (white)
- 2 Chef Hats (white Floppy Hat)
- 2 Neckerchiefs (black)
- 2 Chef/FOH Slacks (black)
- 1 Dress Shirt, First & Last name on right side of shirt (ie. Joe Smith) *color listed on website order form

Estimated total of the uniform cost ordered directly through the New Chef website = \$190.00

In addition to your chef uniform, you need to purchase the following garments and accessories:

- Clean, **black**, closed toe, skid resistant dress shoes **that can be polished** – **NO fabric or mesh**
- **White** undershirts for chef coats and front-of-the-house dress shirts
- **Black** socks, for both front and back of the house (**no ankle length**)
- Black dress belt
- Hair restraints (if needed)
