OPERATIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

Member district insurance brokers have advised that liability exposure for students transporting themselves and others to and from Cascadia Tech is very high. Additionally, districts provide school bus transportation between the sending schools and Cascadia Tech. To reduce risk and maintain cost effective school bus transportation, the Cascadia Technical Academy Superintendents' Administrative Council established the following Operational Rules and Regulation policy:

1. All students will be expected to ride school buses between sending schools and Cascadia Technical Academy during Sessions I & II. Under extenuating circumstances, the sending school principal or his/her designee may grant, in writing, a one-day or temporary driving pass. Long term permission would be granted in exceptional cases by the principal of the sending school or his/her designee.
2. Students attending Cascadia Tech programs may be allowed, with the permission of the sending school principal/designee to drive to a Cascadia Tech program for the reasons listed below:
  - A. No school transportation is available.
  - B. The Cascadia Tech program is an off-campus program.
  - C. Special circumstances with approval of sending school principal/designee and Cascadia Tech Director/designee.

Cascadia Tech programs that currently allow students to drive for the reasons listed in II above are...

- \* Cosmetology 2
- \* Fire Science
- \* Any Session 3 program offerings
- \* Program Internships

Any student qualifying for driving privileges as a result of Section II must show proof of insurance on the vehicle they will be driving.
